The band competition is just one class. All bands will receive \$200 appearance money. In addition to the appearance money, prize money and trophies will be awarded as follows:

1st place receives \$300 + 4 ft. trophy

2nd place receives \$200 + 3 ft. trophy

3rd place receives \$150 + 2 ft. trophy

4th and 5th place receive trophy

Caption awards will be given in the following categories: Best Music, Best General Effect and Best Marching. The Larry Reed Memorial Spirit Award will also be given to the band that best exemplifies the enthusiasm and discipline that Larry always appreciated in top marching bands. This traveling trophy will have the winning schools name placed on it and the trophy will remain at the school through the end of the year.

There's nothing like the fun and excitement of an old-fashioned street parade especially the awards ceremony in the heart of downtown Decatur. What better way to end your marching season than to perform one last time for a captive audience of thousands.
