



# Kekionga Festival

## 2017 OPEN CLASS FLOWER AND VEGETABLE CONTEST AND SHOW

### Entry rules are as follows:

1. **Exhibit check-in** is from **4:00-6:30pm on Friday, August 18** at the Riverside Center. A \$5 entry fee per exhibitor will apply and be collected at check-in. All entries will be on display at the Riverside Center during the Kekionga Festival.
2. Late entries will be exhibited but not judged. Closed judging will begin at 6:30pm by *out of area* judges.
3. Exhibits may be picked up from 4:00-5:00pm on Saturday, August 19. No exhibits may be removed earlier. Prize money can be claimed at the time of exhibit pick-up or at the Adams Co Extension office during regular hours Monday, August 21. Unclaimed prize money, flowers, vases and vegetables will become property of the sponsors.
4. **Flowers and vegetables, in arrangements and specimens, must be grown by the exhibitor.** Exhibitors may enter up to 25 classes, but only one entry per class.
5. Vases, bottles, jars or other containers for flowers are to be provided by the exhibitor. Plates will be provided for the vegetable displays.
6. Containers and accessories are entered at the owner's risk. Sponsors are not responsible or liable for any lost, broken, or stolen items during the show.
7. Prizes will be awarded on the quality of the exhibit. Any class with only one entry does not guarantee a first place finish. If the quality of that exhibit is judged only to be a second or third placing, that award will be given. The decision of the judges will be final.
8. **Prize money will be as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> = \$3.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> = \$2.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> = \$1.00, and Best of Shows = \$5.00.**
9. To speed up the check-in process, please have exhibits marked with section number and class before arrival and your registration form and entry blanks filled out to present at registration time. *Entry blanks will be turned down to conceal your identity during entire judging time, then displayed with exhibits during the show.*
10. The flower/vegetable committee has the right to move entries from the "others" category and form a new category if there is a minimum of three entries in any one class or consolidate categories.
11. Please see the attached list of classes/ registration form and entry blanks that you will present at registration.
